WHAT IS MUSIC THERAPY?

Music therapy is an established and research based health profession. In Europe more than 6000 certified music therapists are working in health and community institutions, schools, care homes or private practices. They provide music therapy for a wide range of client groups across the whole age range - from infants to old age. Music therapists work with people with learning disabilities, autism or behavioural disorders, depression and severe mental health problems, trauma and anxiety, with

Parkinson's disease or Dementia, in hospice care, neurodisability, within prisons and in other settings. A well trained music therapist supports the client in a musical and psychological way and stimulates development or change, as beneficial to the individual's needs. Using music therapy is effective, cost efficient and contributes towards a holistic care environment.

EMTC

The EMTC is the Confederation of professional music therapy associations in Europe. It exists to nurture mutual respect, understanding and exchange between music therapists in Europe. The organization was founded on 15th November 1991 and at this time 30 European countries have joined the EMTC. Started in 2014, European Music Therapy Day is held each year on the 15th of November.
